

Canton Meeting Minutes February 8 2005

Officer reports were taken, as follows:

- * Seneschal: Not present due to illness. Report will be delivered via email. Both the chatelaine and MoAS warrant requests have gone to the Kingdom officers. The 4th Quarter report is done and submitted. The deposit has gone into Camp Loy White.
- * Minister of Arts and Sciences: Not present vial email Would like donations for a demo in a box from canton members. Have contacted the library about display space. There is only one month and area available for 2005, October. The wall space is available, this area is for two dimensional pieces. For 2006, the upper level is available in March, both upper and lower are available in July and the lower level is available in November.

- * Exchequer: The balance of the Canton's funds after paying the site deposit for Inn on the Road is \$1,034.08. Deposits in the amount of \$119.00 were presented by the autocrat for Inn on the Road for reservations. 10 reservations have been made at this time.

The site is once again Camp Loy White, 258 Hull Road, Casar, NC 28020. Site opens at 10:00 am and closes at 10:00 p.m. This site is **Absolutely Bone Dry**. *Anyone who has alcohol on site will be asked to leave and will not get a refund of their event fee.* Sorry, no pets allowed.

As per SCA policy, **minors** must be accompanied by their parents who have signed a waiver for them, or minors must have a minor waiver signed by their parent to turn in when they check in, even if they have a membership card. Minors without waivers cannot be permitted to attend the event.

Directions

From I-40 East or West: Take NC Hwy. 18 towards Shelby. Turn Right on NC Hwy. 10 towards Casar, go about 8 miles, turn Left onto St. Paul's Church Rd., go 2 miles, turn Right on Hull Rd., go ½ mile, Camp Loy White is on the Left.

From I-85 North or South: Take US Hwy. 74 to Shelby, follow Business 74 to the right, after 1.5 miles go north (Right) on NC Hwy. 180. After 5.1 miles turn right on NC Hwy. 18. Go approx. 9 miles & turn Left on Carpenter's Grove Road (there is a sign for Camp Loy White and also one for Belwood Community Center at this intersection). Go 2.5 miles. Turn Left on St. Paul's Church Rd., go 2 miles and turn Left on Hull Rd. Go ½ mile, then Left into Camp Loy White.
